FINAL INSTRUCTIONS:

This Meeting is organized by the Trent Valley Kart Club Governed by the General Regulations of Motorsport UK incorporating the provisions of the FIA International Sporting Code, the Supplementary Regulations of the event and any written instructions that the organizers issue for the meeting. These Final Instructions must be read in conjunction with the Supplementary Regulations of the event.

TIMETABLE

Wednesday 31st July:

Parking up will commence from 09.00 until 23.00

Competitors must NOT set up their equipment/awnings until directed to their parking area by a TVKC Official.

Competitors arriving between 23:00 on Wednesday and 7am on Thursday must park in an orderly waiting line in the rear paddock until parking commences at 7am on Thursday.

If the car park is full or closed do not block the entrance but park on the approach road well over to the side as access is required at all times for emergencies.

No cars officials or otherwise are allowed in the main pit area. No unauthorized Caravans/Motorhomes are allowed in the main pit area. There is a separate grassed caravan/motorhome park to which all such vehicles will be directed.

All Pit Bays must be paid for in advance or will be released to the waiting list.

PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL AISLES ARE KEPT CLEAR.

Ball games, cycling/scooters and any other motorized gadget are not permitted in the paddock and will be dealt with by confiscation until the end of the meeting.

DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AND UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.

Anyone not adhering to these instructions may be asked to leave the circuit at the discretion of TVKC.

Cables and wires crossing the paddock aisles must be covered adequately to reduce the risk of tripping.

Your cooperation is greatly appreciated and will ensure everyone has a fantastic event.

Thursday 1st August:

- Parking up / gates open at 07.00 No cars, Officials or otherwise are allowed in the main pit area. No unauthorized Caravans/Motorhomes are allowed in the main pit area. There is a separate grassed caravan/motorhome park to which all such vehicles will be directed.
- This is an optional Practice day, restricted to Kart Masters competitors only.
- Signing on for this Practice day will be from 07.30 in Race Control.
- Sessions will be timed at 7 Minutes in all classes, starting at 08.30.

- All competitors will need to purchase a Tyre voucher from the JM Racing Shop and present it to the scrutineers when collecting Tyres from Parc Ferme.
- Tyre collection/Scrutineering/and barcoding of equipment will be from 12:00 please see the Official timetable for your class time – please only go to scrutineering in your allocated time.
- Signing on for the Kart Masters Grand Prix will commence at 16:00 until 18:30. You will receive your sticker pack at this time. Please make sure the TVKC & GP logo's are displayed on your Kart.
- Drivers Briefing will be at 12:40 in the panorama room. This will be an official briefing and attendance is mandatory.

Friday 2nd August:

- Parking-up will re-commence at 07.00 No cars, Officials or otherwise are allowed in the main pit area. No Caravans/Motorhomes are allowed in the main pit area. There is a separate grassed caravan/motorhome park to which all such vehicles will be directed.
- Signing on will be from 07.30 – 08.15. You will receive your sticker pack, please ensure the TVKC & GP stickers are displayed prominently on your kart.
- Tyre collection, Scrutineering & Bar coding will be 07.30 – 08.15 (for drivers who did not complete this on Thursday)
- Entrant/Parents and Drivers Briefing will be at 08.15 only for driver not attending the briefing on Thursday at the front of the Dummy Grid
- Official Practice commences from 08.30
- Timed Qualification commences at 10.00
- Lunch break will be after Race 7

Saturday 3rd August:

- Official Practice commences from 08.30
- Timed Qualification commences at 10.00
- Lunch break will be after Race 23
- There will be entertainment and music all weekend in the TVKC village

Sunday 4th August:

- Warm up 8.15 am - Order as per Official Timetable
- B Final will commence at 09.00 (10 minutes + 1lap)
- Pre Finals commence at 09.40 (12 minutes +1lap)

- BREAK FOR LUNCH APPROX 12.15 – During which there will be a Drivers Presentation on track in front of the Grandstand and the class 'Lucky dip' prizes will be made.
- There will be entertainment and music all weekend in the TVKC village
- The Grand Prix will commence at 13:00 (15 minutes +1lap)
- Lap of Honour in parade car after each Grand Prix
- Trophy presentation will be 30 minutes after the last Grand Prix

PARC FERME/STARTING OF ENGINES

There is an area in the paddock specifically for the starting of engines. Pit Bays A11 & B11. This area will be monitored by an Official of the meeting. – Please obey the signs within the area.
