

HONDA STANDING STARTS PROCEDURE 2019

- Karts leave the dummy grid and complete one lap of the circuit slowing as they approach the starting grid, in formation and stop on the RED lines. (or if instructed directly to the grid)
- The grid marshal will walk down the grid and ensure all drives are in the correct position.
- When the check is completed, he will indicate to the starter that the grid is ready.
- The start lights (RED) will come on in sequence, 1 light, 2 lights, 3 lights, 4 lights, very soon the lights will go out – RACE ON – please do not move until the lights go out.
- If another rolling lap is required, the red lights will remain on and a flashing yellow light will appear.
- Starting infringements judged by the Starter or the Start Line Camera/Operator will be penalised by a 5 second penalty. (Motorsport UK Regulation U7.8.1.1)
