

TVKC PRACTICE DAYS 04 & 05 JULY REGULATIONS & GUIDELINES

TVKC are very much looking forward to welcoming our members back to the track. The following regulations and guidelines are in place for the safety of our members, staff, volunteers, and everyone else on site. Please ensure you adhere to these at all times whilst on the premises.

GENERAL REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES

- It is the responsibility of the Entrant that they comply with their own country or regions Covid-19 restrictions on travel.
- Booking will be online for either Saturday OR Sunday not both days.
- The paddock will open at 7am
- The days will be limited to 80 drivers. 20 Cadet, 20 Mini, 20 Junior & 20 Senior. The price will be the usual TVKC practice fee of £65 and sessions will be 15 minutes per category. please see timetable appended to the regulations.
- Each driver will be permitted a Maximum of 2 other people with them.
- You will be required to electronically sign on before arrival and details will be sent via email on how to do this prior to the test day. You will also need to register your vehicle registration number when registering.
- Team Managers will be permitted to the event but will need to register themselves and any team personnel prior to arrival. An email will be sent on how to do this.
- If you or anyone in your household has had coronavirus or are showing symptoms in the last 14 days, please do not come to the venue.
- Spectators will not be permitted at the test days.
- Social distancing must be adhered to at all times whilst on the premises.
- PPE (gloves and Face covering) must be worn at all times whilst in the venue unless you are within your designated parking bay and social distancing can be practiced.
- Masks and gloves will be for sale at the entrance to the venue for anyone not able to provide their own.
- Drivers must wear their helmets with the visor closed at all times from leaving their pit bay to the grid and helmets must remain on until the driver is back I their designated pit bay. When helmets are not being worn a face mask must be worn
- Strictly 1 driver and one mechanic only on the grid. No team managers/parents allowed
- Hand sanitisers will be available in the paddock. Please use these as often as possible and wash your hands regularly
- When working on the karts, these should be spaced a minimum of 4 meters apart and social distancing must be maintained. Awnings are permitted without sides only if social distancing can be maintained within.
- Overnight parking will not be permitted and the paddock must be vacated by 19:00hrs
- There will be no power to the electric hook ups please provide your own source of electric
- The café will be open for takeaway only. The restaurant will remain closed due to current Government guidelines.
- The toilets will be open and maintained/cleaned regularly throughout the day. Please adhere to social distancing when using the facilities
- The Trent Valley Race office will not be open, for general enquiries or emergencies, please contact Danielle Short throughout the day on 07545131099.
- The secondary silencer for all X30 and TKM classes must be used at TVKC events and the PFi circuit.
- The TAG timing system will be in operation. Only drivers with their own transponder will be timed, TVKC will not be hiring out any transponders. If you have your own transponder, please ensure its charged and fitted correctly.
- The TVKC COVID-19 risk assessment is available on the TVKC website and social media pages.
- The Tannoy will not be in use on 04 & 05 July except for urgent information and calling drivers to the Clerk.



ARRIVAL AND PARKING

- The gate will open at 7am and on arrival you will be temperature checked.
- All electronic documents must be completed, signed and logged before arrival. You will be emailed these documents prior to arrival.
- Masks and gloves must be worn from this point onwards whilst in the confines of the venue. PPE can be purchased at the gate. Masks £2.00 and gloves 50p per pair. Please have the correct money as change will not be given.
- Please follow the officials instructions when parking, you will be asked to leave 1 bay between your bay and the person parked next to you. Teams using consecutive bays please ensure karts are 4 meters apart.
- Awnings are permitted in the case of adverse weather but sides must be left out of the awnings.



ON TRACK ACTIVITY

- Drivers must wear their helmet from leaving their pit bay with the visor closed until they have finished their session and returned to their pit bay. Mechanics must wear their face mask at all times when not in their pit bay.
- There is a one way system in place that must be followed at all times.
- When placing the kart on the grid, the driver must be wearing their helmet with the visor closed and gloves must be worn, mechanics must be wearing gloves and a mask.
- Please place your kart behind one of the cone markers on the grid, mechanics and drivers please remain by your kart and social distance from others on the grid apart from taking the trolly to the trolly park
- The trolly park has been marked with yellow X's on the ground please park your trolly on an available X.
- Once the session has started, all mechanics must proceed to the grandstand where social distancing must be respected, masks must also be worn at all times. 1 person per yellow box. The middle row cannot be used to watch but may be used as a walkway. The Grandstand and perimeter banks are the only spectating areas to be used.
- After the chequered flag, there will be a 3 minute pause in between sessions to allow mechanics of drivers on track to leave the grandstand in plenty of time before the next session starts to ensure no crossover of people, mechanics must return to the trolley park using the same one way system they used to enter the grid to collect their trolleys.










EXITING THE CIRCUIT

- At the end of the session when the driver brings his/her kart into the pit lane, they must park their kart in one of the available bays (all 2.5m apart). There are 20 bays around the pit area so there is no excuse not to do this!
- When lifting kart back onto the trolley, the driver must have their visor closed and mechanic wearing mask and gloves.
- Drivers will not be permitted to come in to make set up changes and return to the circuit. Once you leave the circuit your session is over.
