

## TRENT VALLEY KART CLUB DRIVERS BRIEFING November 2024

- WELCOME We hope you have a safe and enjoyable race meeting.
- MEETING FORMAT & TIMETABLE You will have received via email the timetable and Final Instructions (if any) for the event. In order to maintain reduced noise levels for our surrounding residents, the tanoy will be limited in use. Please keep checking your timetable. It is your responsibility to be in the right place at the right time thank you.
- TVKC 'APP' Please check with Danielle Short/Clare Mills regarding access to the new 'app' it will have access to live timing and various other bits of useful meeting information and will be used as a communication tool to interact directly with you.
  - <u>PRACTICE SESSIONS</u> Transponders must be fitted For ALL sessions, as must your allocated Race Numbers (all 4 sides please)
- **<u>DUMMY GRID</u>** Please ensure you follow the instructions from the officials no working on the grid with tools. (Tyre pressure checks only). Also if you leave your grid slot you must go directly to the track (unless mechanical issues)
- TIMED QUALIFYING Driver's average time calculated from their fastest 3 laps during their TQ session will be used as their qualifying time, for drivers completing less than the required minimum 3 laps average lap times will still be calculated and then ranked initially by laps completed and then by average time behind drivers completing more than 3 laps. Should a driver have their fastest lap cancelled due to a penalty then the next fastest 3 laps will be used for calculating their average time. 'Rolling over' causing a danger to other drivers will be penalised.
- <u>GRID ASSEMBLY</u> For Timed Qualifying grid slots will be allocated by current Championship Standing, there is no gate closing time.
- **GRID ASSEMBLY** For Race the Grid Gate closes 2 minutes prior to the end of the previous track action. Not on the grid on time = no Race. Please be on the grid in good time and DO NOT IMPEDE others accessing the entry gate.
- <u>MEETING STATUS</u> Digi boards are now installed on the entrance to Parc Ferme and the back of the Dummy Grid, you should now easily be informed if the event is: DRY/OPEN/WET. Please use the facility to ensure you arrive with the correctly fitted tyres and a reminder Grid Gates have a closing time not on the grid = no race!
- ENTRY ONTO THE TRACK when the green flag/light is shown please leave the grid and enter the track, within aprox 45 seconds the gates will close until the main pack of drivers have passed the grid exit, only then will you be allowed out, this must be done at slow speed and in safety also please ensure you blend into the track using the pit exit lane marked out by white lines. During Practice sessions/warm ups/TQ drivers maybe restricted as to when they can enter the track by the Grid Marshal, when entering the track DO NOT IMPEDE OTHER DRIVERS DANGEROUS MANOUVERS MAY MEAN A BLACK FLAG AND/OR REPORT TO THE STEWARDS. If a driver is unable to start from the 'Dummy Grid' after the display of the green flag and he receives intervention from a mechanic, he will be authorised to leave the 'pre grid' only on the orders of the grid marshal or official and he/she must take the start from the back of the formation irrespective of the number of rolling laps.

- EXIT FROM THE TRACK The exit from the track is after marshal post 8, you need to approach at a slow speed, keep apart and await official's instructions. Please remain seated in your kart until instructed by an official to exit, There are cameras in parc ferme so please do not attempt to re-attach your nose cone IT WILL BE PENALISED USING VIDEO EVIDENCE!
- MARSHALS POSTS There are 9 Marshal posts and all posts will use flags and lights to communicate to you.
- ROLLING STARTS There will be yellow flags & lights at posts 8 & 9 no overtaking is permitted after post 8. Please keep a slow, steady and constant speed and keep within the tram lines as you approach the start. Wait for the lights to go out then race on. The 'FULL' circuit must be used at all times FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN A MINIMUM MANDATORY 1 LAP PENALTY THIS APPLIES IN RACE ALSO.

Please note overtaking at anytime on a rolling lap after Post 8 will result in a report/penalty - 'overtaking under the yellow flag'. Tyre warming on the rolling lap – excessive and dangerous manoeuvres will be reported to the stewards.

- **TRAM LINES** Slow steady speed round last corner Accelerating towards the Yellow line/cones Lights out race on. Light stay on + Flashing amber + False start flags one more formation lap.
- ACCELERATION LINE/YELLOW LINE 25mts from the Start line is the Yellow line + cones this is an indication of where we expect you to start accelerating for a race start (not before!)
- **FIRST CORNER** conditions could make the first corner 'tricky' please have respect for each other and the track limits.
- <u>CIRCUIT CAMERAS</u> There are 30 circuit cameras in operation covering the whole of the circuit and over 16 cameras in operation in the Parc Ferme area.
- QUARTER FLAGS The Quarter flags may be used during a race, please observe and respect the flags.
- <u>DIGI FLAG</u> The Digi flag is located on the start line gantry and all signals will be communicated from the Digi Flag.
- **DRIVING STANDARDS** A Time Penalty of 5 seconds maybe applied by the Clerk of the Course (or his Deputy) if he/she considers a driver has acted inappropriately on track and contrary to the Code of Driving Conduct (including blocking and track limits) to which there is no appeal to either the decision or the penalty. (As per the International Sporting Code and Motorsport UK Yearbook) for further information please refer to Final Instructions.
- RACE with RESPECT TVKC support the Motorsport UK Race with Respect code. Please race hard but fair. The Race with Respect code extends off the track and into the paddock too between competitors and their associates along with the officials of the meeting.

## • STARTING OF ENGINES

A quick 2/3 second 'fire up' of engines is allowed in your awning and/or parc ferme pre your track action. Excessive fire up time/engine running is not allowed in the paddock at all. Any non compliance = £100 fine plus possible other club sanctions.

• PADDOCK REGULATIONS - Bikes, scooters, ball games etc are banned from the paddock throughout the meeting. We hope we don't have to but any Bikes/Scooters/Balls being used will be taken away until the end of the meeting when a £100 release fee will be required.

NO TYRES TO BE LEFT IN THE PADDOCK – take home or speak to TKH for disposal.

The access roads must remain clear at all times. Cables passing over road/walk ways must be covered/protected.

There may be spot checks made on fire extinguishers within your awnings/pit bays.

FLOOR PROTECTION/GROUND SHEETS WILL BE REQUIRED IN THE PADDOCK.

Please ensure your rubbish is bagged or put in bins and leave the premises as you found them – thank you.
