

INNER PADDOCK REGULATIONS FOR ANNUAL RENTAL 2021

- **INNER PADDOCK ACCESS IS FOR VEHICLES ISSUED WITH A PADDOCK PASS ONLY** - Spaces in the Inner Paddock at Trent Valley Kart Club meetings are at a premium and access will only be granted to those who have reserved a bay and correctly displayed their paddock pass. Your vehicle must be parked within your designated bay, TVKC reserve the right to revoke your vehicle pass if cannot fit your vehicle within your bay.
- **PADDOCK PASS SYSTEM** – in order to make the paddock access run smoothly, an agreed number of paddock passes will be issued to owner of the rented bay and it is their responsibility to ensure that the passes are displayed correctly in all vehicles. If vehicles are changed then the passes must be transferred across, it is the owner's responsibility to ensure this happens, one pass per vehicle. If your vehicle does not have a pass, security will not permit entry to the paddock. *Please do not ask for a pass for a non-working motorhome/caravan as you will not be issued with one.*
- **MOTORHOMES & CARAVANS** - if you are bringing a motorhome or caravan and it is **NOT BEING USED TO RUN YOUR KART OUT OF**, i.e. a working vehicle, it must be parked at the back of the outer paddock or grass area leaving the roadways clear, see image 1 & 2 below. If it is found during the event that a non-working motorhome or caravan is in the inner paddock, TVKC reserves the right to revoke the pass and refund any future bookings. Please note there are electric points you can connect to in the outer paddock, that we do not charge for.
- **PRIVATE CARS** – any private car that has not been issued with a paddock pass must be parked in the designated car park area, see image 1 below.
- **AWNING FASTENINGS** – drilling and the use of raw bolts is permitted for fastening your awnings in the inner and outer paddocks. Using stakes is not permitted and TVKC reserve the right to request payment for any repair work required.
- **TEAMS RENTING OUT BAYS** – if none of your drivers are entered into the meeting, TVKC reserves the right to rent out your bays ahead of that meeting.
- **BAY SIZE** – each main bay is 8m x 6m. There are 6 smaller bays G1 – G6 by the entrance. It is your responsibility to make sure that your vehicle fits inside the bay and does not overhang into the roadways, which must be kept clear for emergency vehicles. You may be asked to move your vehicle if it does not fit.
- **COST** - each main bay is £375 for the year. The G bays are £325 for the year. For those who held a 2020 bay then the 2019 costs of £325 and £275 for the G bays will be held. For 5 or more bays the 5th bay onwards is half price.
- **WHAT'S INCLUDED** – there are multi-point electric plug-in points which are accessible from all bays. Power is supplied between the hours of 7am -11pm. Overnight parking is paid by TVKC to the circuit management on your behalf. The bay is rented for the 11 club meetings and Kartmasters Grand Prix. It does not include any visiting Championships.
- **NON-TRANSFERABLE** - Pit spaces are **NOT TRANSFERABLE** and **MUST NOT** be sub-rented to another party. If you do not require the bay(s) for one or more meetings please inform us on pitbays@tvkc.co.uk. During the meeting the club reserves the right to allocate your space to another party if you do not arrive.
- **PAYMENT** – you will be invoiced for your required bays; payment for annual bays must be made in full within 7 days of receiving notice that your bay request has been accepted. Payment for weekend bays must be made upon receipt of invoice. If payment is not received within this time, the bay(s) may be given to someone else.
